Lilley Dog Field Terms and Conditions

ALL USERS/BOOKINGS AGREE TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

You & Your Dogs

Please ensure that your dogs are adequately vaccinated to use a public place. If your dog is showing any signs of illness DO NOT use the field and be respectful of other pets and their owners.

Entirely At Your Own Risk

The field may have uneven ground, long grass etc. You agree that your use of the field is entirely at your own risk and agree not to hold 'Lilley Dog Field', its owners or staff responsible for any injury to you, your family/friends or your dog's arising from your use of the field howsoever caused. The field is a large outdoor space and contains areas of uneven ground which could be concealed under long grass or other vegetation, has overhanging branches from trees around the edges which may fall or have fallen and could contain other hazards consistent with the countryside. You agree not to let anyone else onto the field other than any friends or family members you have brought with you to enjoy walking your dogs. By bringing friends or family, or sending somebody in place of you, you agree that you take full responsibility for their safety and for ensuring that they always abide by these terms and conditions whilst using the field.

Children

You are welcome to bring your children to the field, but they must be supervised at all times. You are responsible for making sure that they do not injure themselves or break any of these terms and conditions. Please be aware that the field has not been made 'child safe', and that certain elements may pose an additional hazard to children (non-child proof dog poo bins for example).

Buildings and Livestock

You agree not to enter any buildings near the site, to keep at a safe distance from any horses/livestock using the nearby fields, and ensuring your dogs are always on their leads when nearby to reduce any possible risk to horses and their riders if in close contact.

The Fence

Although we will be inspecting and maintaining the fence regularly, holes or other damage to the fence may occur from time to time due to a number of reasons including digging by dogs or other animals, falling trees or branches, and general wear and tear. If

you become aware of any issue with the state of the fence, please let us know immediately so that we can make other users aware and so that we can fix it as soon as possible. We cannot, however, take any responsibility for any dog escaping the field whether this is through a defect in the fence or any incidence, and regardless of whether we have notified you in advance or not.

Using The Field

- 1. It is your responsibility to pick up all of your dog's waste and dispose of it in the mess bins provided.
- 2. You must enter the field and close the gate before letting your dog(s) out of your vehicle to ensure the safety of the dog(s), nearby road users and members of the public.
- 3. Please ensure that you do not arrive early for your booking. If you do, please wait as far up the drive as possible and do not let your dog out of the car prior to your allotted time.
- 4. Vacate the field in good time and promptly just before the end of your session, leaving it secure at the end of your booking. Padlock the gate and leave the digits returned to 0000.
- 5. Please only park on the hardstanding (i.e. the gravelled area) within the field gate and not on the grass. If you have multiple cars for one booking you can park on the hardstanding outside the field.
- 6. Any issues must be reported in a poilite and calm manner to Samantha or Simon on the numbers provided on the booking forms/website.

Bookings

Bookings can be re-scheduled, but we need at least 48 hours' notice but are nonrefundable. Refunds are totally at the discretion of the managers of Lilley Dog Field and dependent on the circumstances. All bookings must be paid for in advance – either by cash if arranged BEFORE use with Simon or Sam or card via the website/invoice raised.

Updates

We may need to vary these terms and conditions from time to time. When we do this, we will let you know via email/update this document. By making a booking, you agree to abide by the terms and conditions on the website at the time of making your booking.
